

Medallion 1

- Clue 1 - I'm not on the lake, I'm not on the river. If I fell in the water, I know I would shiver. But I'm close to the river, I can tell you that. Is the river the Ash or is it the Rat?
- Clue 2 - The part of the trail I'm on doesn't get much play. Most sleds drop down through the "tails" and then zoom away. If they went straight ahead they would have a nice ride. The trail is usually smooth & there's lots of place to hide.
- Clue 3 – When I'm dead & gone, spread my Ash here. It's just a hop, skip & jump to get a cold beer. The trail's dark green on the map then hits light green & dark red. I'm on the dark green part – keep that in your head.
- Clue 4 – If I did have that beer, I'd go almost straight across the ice to get back. The trail's right there, just follow the track. My old rusty (no, not THAT Rusty) car is in the woods for all to see. But don't go that far, I'm by the birch tree.
- Clue 5 – It's more than one birch – there are three on the right. I'm under the little pine that the birches guard day & night. The trail curves to the left – we're all on the right. Pretty close to the curve but under the pine, out of sight.

Medallion 2

- Clue 1 – Medallion 2 is close to the road. Which road? Think about all of the trails that run close to roads...hmmmm. I bet it's by that road where there's snow and trees and stuff. Check the map.
- Clue 2 – Let's Get This Party Started! Who sang that song? Knowing that will get you to the right color trail. The Arrow(s) will take you to this trail and keep you on the trail to the medallion.
- Clue 3 – O.K...so, are you on the right trail? Next to the right road? If you're right, you'll score **100** and you'll be in the pink! Things are pointing this way and that way...arrows, close to the road but still on a trail...headed to the wood land where there's lots of trees and birds and stuff.
- Clue 4 – Don't be a bird-brain. Look around. The medallion may be just off the trail.
- Clue 5 – Someone has decided to feed the birds out here in the middle of nowhere. They haven't fed them in a while though. If you look under the feeder you'll see no seeds on the ground.

Medallion #3

- Clue 1 - Don't fly by, turn & give it a try. #3 is on K3
- Clue 2 - Some trees are big, some are small, some are dead, some are tall, but only one is worth \$20.00.
- Clue 3 - Get out of the pond and through the swamp I'm on high ground but down deep.

- Clue 4 - My tree is just right; not so tall that a logger would want to fall and not so small that the crazies can run us over!!
- Clue 5 - My tree is so well known that it even has a name after Stacy tried to run me over years ago. I've been call STACY'S TREE

Medallion 4

- Clue 1 - I'm on the same trail as Medallion # 1 but I'm much farther west – the ride will be fun! I'm not in the snow – someone hid me on high. No shovel needed, just look when you go by.
- Clue 2 – If you're on the Bill Morgan, you gotta be near. I'm not in the brook but I can see it from here. On the right side of the trail as you head to the west. Search before the bridge, that would be best.
- Clue 3 – In the Cedar swamp, that's a good place to look. I'm steps away from the bridge that's over Daley Brook. To the right of the trail as you head to Kab Lake – slow down, there's the bridge, you wanna hit the brake.
- Clue 4 – So you're at the bridge, on the Bill Morgan Trail. The clues are still sketchy – maybe you should check your tree mail?
- Clue 5 – The signs are all there on the right side of the trail. A sawed tree is there – with a hole for M (medallion) mail! The hole in the tree holds me, the gold fob. Find me there and you've done a great job!

Medallion 5

- Clue 1 – Get a map. Check out the Kabetogama and Ray Inset. What a mess, eh? Welcome to Medallion Hell. # 5 is in there...somewhere. We have to be vague; it's day 1, for God's sake.
- Clue 2 – Got your map? Get on the sleds and let's go for a ride! If you're on Ash River, head NW, if you're in Ericsburg, I. Falls or Ray, head SE. Wow, still pretty vague and it's day 2. How about we all meet on the trail and we cook some dawgs and talk about it?
- Clue 3 - Boy, they're logging this crap out of this area. But if you aren't in the logging, you're in Medallion territory. # 5 is NOT in the logging area. It's between where the beavers give a dam and CR 122. Maybe you can get to the root of the problem before someone else does.
- Clue 4 - If you aren't there already, you will soon find out the T' Dawg is a nice trail. Lots of curves, some straights, swamps, deer stands, trees everywhere...some of those trees have fallen over. Medallion # 5 is at a place in the trail that looks like "nature's bookends." Figure it out. This isn't spose to be easy. But you can get there from this clue. Stop, look & THINK!
- Clue 5 – So, day 5. I'm disappointed that this hasn't been found. You're riding too fast and your helmet's so tight your brain ain't workin'! Look for "nature's bookends" – 2 trees that fell over, opposite directions, exposing their roots to the Tone Dawg Trail and forming what looks like

“bookends” with the trail in between. The medallion is in one of the roots – right or left – you make the call. In a plastic container w/ a blue top. You must have the container when you claim your prize. Please, no littering.

Medallion 6

- Clue 1 - I'm up north, so watch your speed or the DNR will, and don't go before noon (Lu sleeps in don't ya know).
- Clue 2 - If you didn't get a ticket and have time to kill, keep to the left on the Arrowhead. But if you see a train you went too far.
- Clue 3 - If you obey all the signs then you should be going slow. Take a look I have pines before and after but none by me.
- Clue 4 - I don't live here alone in fact just across the trail is a house with a big family and they even chomped on my house.
- Clue 5 - If not for the sign this dead head could be cut, the beavers already started the job so take caution and dig down.

Medallion 7

- Clue 1 - I have a price on my head (\$20) cuz I know too much. I see who comes and goes, so you better hurry; Rusty is close.
- Clue 2 - A lot go past me cuz they hear Phil has gas. My placer prefers a paper and Ellen's sweets.
- Clue 3 - Those bikes were a drag, the one guy almost stepped on me. My hiding spot is not that good; only some twigs and a lot of snow.
- Clue 4 - If I'm still not found you must hurry up, all the sleds at Gateway one may run my wind fall down.
- Clue 5 - I must be found - I'm on the north side about 1/2 way down in small windfall on the ground.

Medallion 8

- Clue 1 - My old friend Bill he loved this trail, so take you time I'm not far off it.
- Clue 2 - So many just fly by, don't give in - its slow and steady to win

- Clue 3 - By now you know I'm where you can go fast. But here's something new. I'm not by a tree, I'm by something man made.
- Clue 4 - This buzzing has to stop! I seen many of you on day one and again today see you don't need a sled to play.
- Clue 5 - Don't be down in the DUMP I'm just off to the side. Only a phone call away!!

Medallion 9

- Clue 1 – If I was a medallion and wanted to be hidden, I would find me a trail that is a little less ridden. The trail would be twisty and turny and slow, giving people some time to admire the snow.
- Clue 2 – I would start at #26, that place on the map then head north from there – tighten that chin strap! I would cross 122 twice and head for the lake. There's some tight turns and some trees – some time you should take.
- Clue 3 – Sharp turn to the left – it's not marked very good. Hit this corner too fast and you'll have trees on your hood. You've past the main challenge and the riding is clear, but Woody would want you to watch out for his deer.
- Clue 4 – The Cedars form a V – a fallen tree splits the two. I'm under THAT tree – hidden well, peek-a-boo! A sweet little place where I just seem to fit...a cozy spot on Woody's trail you'll never forget.
- Clue 5 - From Voyageur Marine and that Jeep with the plow, if you ride like a mile, you'll see 2 Cedars, like now! On the left side of the trail, 2 Cedars form a V. Hopefully you can see the forest for the tree! The Cedars stand tall and another crashed and fell. I'm under that fallen tree...I wish you well.

Medallion 10

- Clue 1 - I'm north of the Tone Dawg. So pack a lunch and load the kids, it's a hunting you must go.
- Clue 2 - Go past K3 but not to the Hagerman. That doesn't help much so you may as well cook lunch.
- Clue 3 - Keep a eye on the fire and the kids off the shelter. It's closer to the ground if you're a medallion hunter.
- Clue 4 - One if by trail, Two if by river (Tom Cod) don't get wet feet - the fire's almost out.
- Clue 5 - Keep you feet dry - stay on top NE corner bridge by bush
